This update from AC Transit:

The [Oakland Running Festival](#) (Marathon, Half Marathon, Team Relay, and 5K) will temporarily close streets in many parts of Oakland, including downtown and the West Oakland, Fruitvale, Rockridge, and Montclair districts. There will be service delays and route detours in and between these areas. Please visit [AC Transit's Oakland Marathon webpage](#) for more details about the detours. Note that lines 14, 54, and 62 will be canceled, partially replaced with a [shuttle](#), and Line 26 will only operate in a [one-way loop](#) serving downtown Oakland, West Oakland BART, and Emeryville.
