Embarcadero Bridge Closure, May 2016 thru May 2018

Construction on the Embarcadero Bridge will begin on Wednesday, May 11<sup>th</sup>. During construction, the Embarcadero between Estuary Park and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue will be closed. The new bridge will be wider and will include bike lanes, a sidewalk and a multi-use path on the Estuary side. It will also have a higher clearance over the water to continue the City's efforts to reconnect Lake Merritt with the Estuary.
