Leaf Blowers

For those of you who use gardeners, please check with them to see that they follow these common sense steps if you're away while they perform their duties. (Otherwise your neighbors suffer the consequences!)

- 1) Don't use leaf blowers before 8am or after 6pm
- 2) Use the lowest throttle speed needed to get the job done.
- 3) Please be considerate of passersby and open doors and windows.
- 4) Don't use leaf blowers to clean up large amounts of debris like gravel or construction dirt.
